

praising God, and thanking Jesus.






Make a Game for Giving Thanks

1. Fold the paper from the top right corner down so the edges line up. Cut or tear off the leftover piece.




2. Fold the triangle in half.




3. Fold the new triangle in half.



4. When you open it, you should have 8 small triangles.




5. Think of some people, special event (like your birthday or Christmas) or things for which you are thankful.
6. Write or draw one of those things/people in each triangle.
7. Place your paper clip or bobby pin in the center of your paper.
8. Now put the point of your crayon or pencil in the middle of the paper clip or bobby pin.
9. You can now use the paper clip or bobby pin as a spinner.
10. Spin to select one person or thing for which you are thankful and share why you are thankful.




Make a Poof Book


1. Fold the paper in half the long way, like a hot dog.



2. Open the paper and fold it in half the short way, like a hamburger.



3. Take one layer of paper, flip the edge back to meet the fold, and crease.



4. Turn the paper over, flip the edge of the paper back to meet the fold, and crease.




5. Place the paper on the table so that you see a W when you look at the end


6. Cut the center of the W along the center fold. You'll be cutting through two layers of paper and stopping at the cross fold.



7. With your wrists above your fingers, hold the two halves of the hot dog from the top.




8. Turn your wrists to the sides. You will have an open book with four sections.






9. Bring three of the sections together.

Fold the last section on top of the other three so that you have a flat book.


